HEADSTONE HIGHLIGHTS



The Wells Theatre in Downtown Norfolk is named after its founders, Jake and Otto Wells. The theatre recently celebrated its 100th anniversary having started in 1913. Of the more than 40 theatres that the Wells Brothers owned throughout the country (they were actually cousins) the Norfolk Wells was their flagship theatre. In addition to being a theater owner, Jake was also a major league baseball player having played for Detroit and St. Louis.

Following a bout with depression, Jake committed suicide in 1927. Otto passed from natural causes in 1940.

The Wells lot is located across from the infant/child section.

Update on the Triangle Garden Statue

Many lot owners and visitors have inquired on the whereabouts of the Blessed Mother statue in the triangle garden. The statue was part of a vandalism incident that occurred in 2011 and it sustained damage that is not repairable. Since that incident, many of the marble base tiles that had already been repaired once before began to fall off again.

The cemetery board is considering the replacement of the existing base with a granite base. The base will be used as a memorial wall to those interred at St. Mary's whose locations cannot be determined. Family and friends will be able to purchase space on the memorial wall and have the names of their loved ones engraved. The memorial wall will include a plaque with the names of the original contributors that was never placed as promised on the old base.

Once the memorial base is in place, a new granite statue of the Blessed Mother will be mounted on top. Anyone wishing to contribute toward this project should place "Triangle Memorial Garden" in the memo area of their check.
