The site preparation and pile driving phase has been completed and crews from Ingram are now preparing the site for the foundation. The scheduled completion date is January 2009.

The first lighting for 2008 will take place on Good Friday, March 21 to burn through Easter Sunday. The candles are lit seven times a year. Other holidays and feast days for candle lightings include Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, All Souls Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

With an annual donation of \$100, a beautiful red votive will burn on your lot for an estimated 4 days and nights.
