

SPRING CLEANUP REMINDER

Christmas and other winter decorations that are not in permanent containers will be removed during the second week of March to prepare for the upcoming mowing and trimming season. Please note that cemetery regulations prohibit the planting of trees, shrubs, or any other ground covers on lots or placing anything not in permanent containers that would interfere with normal mowing and trimming operations. Other holidays and feast days for candle lightings include Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, All Souls Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. With an annual donation of \$125, a beautiful red votive will burn on your lot for an estimated 4 days and nights. Funeral flowers are usual removed from the grave si 7-10 days following a service Immediate family members who desire to keep vases, basket etc. should remove them during this time frame.

Bending the stems of artifici flowers prior to inserting the into a container will usually kee the flowers from falling out of the container and/or blowing away c windy days. Stuffing contained with newspaper is also a good way to secure artificial flowers.
