

Please note that cemetery regulations prohibit the planting of trees, shrubs, or any other ground covers on lots or placing anything not in permanent containers that would interfere with normal mowing and trimming operations. VOTIVE CANDLES

The first lighting for 2010 will take place on Good Friday, April 2nd to burn through Easter Sunday. The candles are lit 7 times a year. Other holidays and feast days for candle lightings include Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, All Souls Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. With an annual donation of \$125, a beautiful red votive will burn on your lot for an estimated 4 days and nights. Please note that your annual donation generates funds for cemetery upkeep as well as the cemetery's endowment fund. BRONZE VASES AND LAMPS


