HEADSTONE HIGHLIGHTS

The Infant/Child Section located south of the old main driveway began at *St. Mary's Cemetery* on November 5, 1949. To date, there are 284 infants and 14 children (up to age 5) buried in this shady and serene setting. Most of the plots are marked by numerous white marble angel and lamb statues along with small granite headstones. Large oak and cedar trees accentuate the landscaping as a final resting place.

Building and site plans have been submitted to the permit department for issuance of a building permit. The cemetery board is hopeful that ground breaking and construction can begin in the upcoming weeks.
