


VOTIVE CANDLES AT ST. MARY'S CEMETERY

Due to price increases from our supplier, votive candles for the 2009 season will sell for \$125. The red votive candles illuminate the cemetery on All Souls Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter, Mothers Day, Memorial Day, and Fathers Day and burn for approximately 4 days and nights.

Keep in mind that your purchase of a red votive candle generates funds for cemetery upkeep as well as the cemetery's endowment fund.
