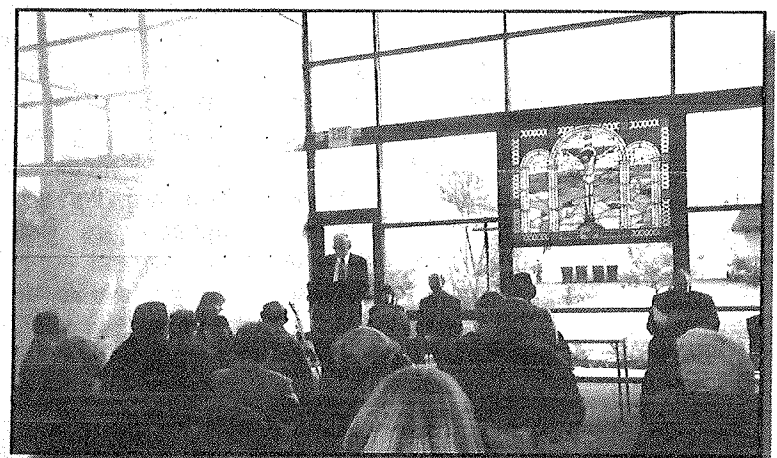
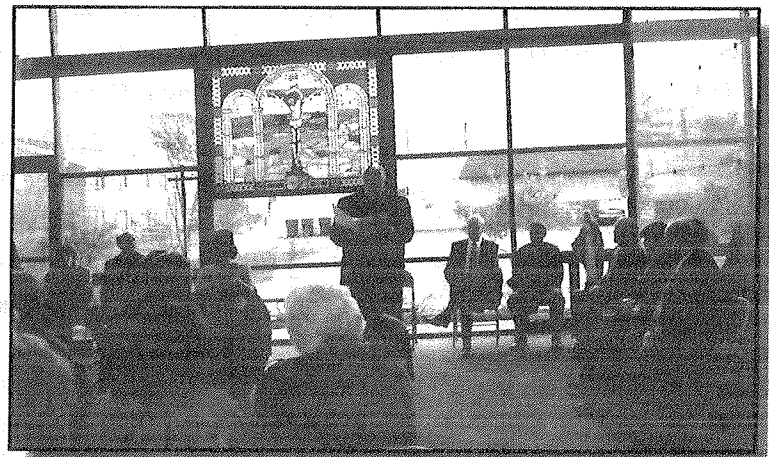

Chapel Mausoleum Dedication Ceremony ~ Highlights ~ February 22, 2009

The new chapel mausoleum was dedicated on Sunday, February 22, 2009, by Bishop Francis X. DiLorenzo. Fr. Dan Klem, Pastor of Sacred Heart Church, started the ceremony with an opening prayer. Board President Jim Fitzpatrick gave the keynote address and introduced Bishop DiLorenzo. In attendance were area clergy, members of the cemetery board and staff, and Bob Maines with Ingram Construction. The St. Gregory Contemporary Choir provided music and song before the ceremony. The stained glass window displayed on the back wall was donated by Board Member John Langlois and crypt owner Pat Amland. The ceremony was attended by approximately 40 people and a light reception followed.
